ORDINANCE NO. 2023-14
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 7, MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC,
CHAPTER 5, “TRAFFIC SCHEDULES”
OF THE MAPLE PARK VILLAGE CODE

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Maple Park, Illinois has determined after careful review that modification of the traffic schedules within the Maple Park Municipal Code is appropriate with regard to stop intersections within the Village;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Maple Park, Illinois as follows:

Section One: That Title 7, Chapter 5 Section 7-5-1 of the Village of Maple Park Village Code shall be hereby amended to revise said section as follows:

7-5-1: STOP STREETS:

- A) One-Stop Streets: The following intersections, involving a “T” termination of the stop street listed below, shall be designated with one (1) stop sign being posted at the intersection as listed below:

- B) Two-Way Stops: Two (2) stop signs shall be posted at the intersections as listed below:

- C) **Three-Way Stops:** Three (3) stop signs shall be posted at the intersection listed below, as follows:

Liberty and Main -- stop signs shall be posted on Liberty Street going north and south and on Main Street proceeding west. No stop sign shall be posted on Main Street proceeding east. 2013-07, 4-2-2013

- D) **Four-Way Stops:** The following intersections shall be designated as four-way stops:

Section Two: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage, approval and publication as required by law.

Section Three: That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict or inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinances are hereby repealed to the extent of any such conflict or inconsistency.

Section Four: That if any part or portion of this ordinance shall be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such partial invalidity shall not affect the remainder of this ordinance.

Section Five: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as hereby authorized to be done by the President and Board of Trustees.

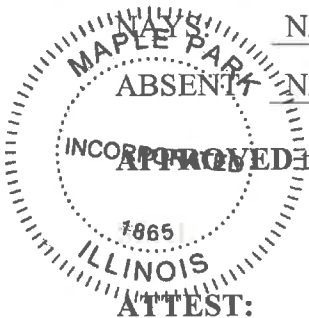

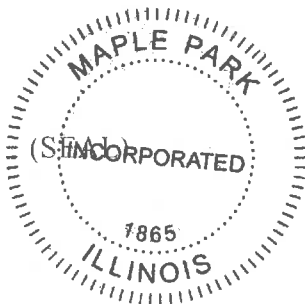
