**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 1  
ADMINISTRATION, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE  
VILLAGE OF MAPLE PARK, CHAPTER 5,  
COMPENSATION, SECTION B PRESIDENT, SUBSECTION  
1.**

**WHEREAS**, the Illinois Revised Statutes, Chapter 24, Section 3-13-2 *et seq.* provides, in part, as follows:

“The appropriate authority of any municipality may fix the salary of all officers who are elected for a definite term in an ordinance other than the appropriation ordinance;” and

**WHEREAS**, the Municipal Code of the Village of Maple Park, Illinois presently provides for the payment of the following salaries:

President and liquor control commissioner \$5,200 per annum

**WHEREAS**, said salary amounts were determined and established on July 1, 2008; and

**WHEREAS**, there have been no changes to the salaries since that time; and

**WHEREAS**, the Finance and Public Relations and Development have recommended this change;

**THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES** of the Village of Maple Park, Kane and DeKalb Counties, Illinois, that Section 6-5-B of the Maple Park Village Code be amended as follows:

**SECTION 1.** That Title 1 Village Officers and Employees, Chapter 5, Compensation, Section B, President, Subsection 1, be amended as follows:

**B. President:**

1. Compensation of the president that is elected as of the 2019 Consolidated Election, effective upon the commencement of the term of office of said president and trustee:

President and liquor control commissioner	\$2,000
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2. Each elected official is permitted two (2) excused absences from the regular meetings of the Board of Trustees held during the fiscal year. Additional absences by any of said officials from the regular Board of Trustees’ meetings shall result in the said official not being paid for such regular meeting not attended.

**SECTION 2. VALIDITY**

- A. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent that they conflict with this ordinance, or any part of this Ordinance.

B. If any provision contained in this ordinance is found to be invalid, such provision shall be deemed to be severable and shall not affect the validity of any of the remaining provision of the ordinance.

**SECTION 3. ORDINANCE IN FORCE**

A. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
