**RESOLUTION APPROVING A CONTRACT FOR THE 2019
MFT CENTER STREET PAVING PROJECT TO CURRAN
CONTRACTING COMPANY OF CRYSTAL LAKE,
ILLINOIS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$174,000.**

WHEREAS, Village has determined that it is necessary to provide for the maintenance of streets and storm sewers within the Village;

WHEREAS, the Village sought bids for the 2019 MFT Center Street Paving Project; and,

WHEREAS, the Village of Maple Park will require all contractors to meet the requirements of the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act; and,

WHEREAS, on Tuesday, September 10, 2019, sealed bids were opened and read aloud for the Village of Maple Park 2019 MFT Center Street Paving Project;

WHEREAS, two (2) bids were received, and the lowest responsible bidder was Curran Contracting Company, Crystal Lake, Illinois, in the amount of \$174,000.

WHEREAS, the Village President and Board of Trustees have determined that entering into the Contract with Curran Contracting Company of Crystal Lake, Illinois will serve and be in the best interest of the Village; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Maple Park as follows:

SECTION 1: RECITALS. The facts and statements contained in the preamble to this Resolution are found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted as part of this Resolution.

SECTION 2: APPROVAL OF THE CONTRACT. The Contract by and between the Village and Curran Contracting Company, Crystal Lake, Illinois, is hereby approved in the amount of \$174,000.00, in substantially the form attached to this Resolution as Exhibit A.

SECTION 3: EXECUTION OF THE CONTRACT. The Village President and the Village Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute and attest, on behalf of the Village, the Contract upon receipt by the Village Clerk of at least one original copy of the Contract executed by Curran Contracting Company provided, however, that if the executed copy of the Contract is not received by the Village Clerk within 30 days after the effective date of this Resolution, then this authority to execute and attest will, at the option of the President and Board of Trustees, be null and void.

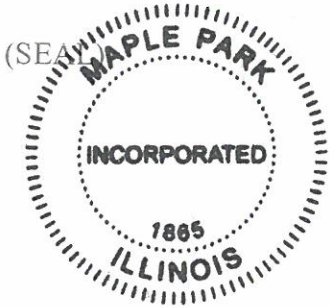
SECTION 4: EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
