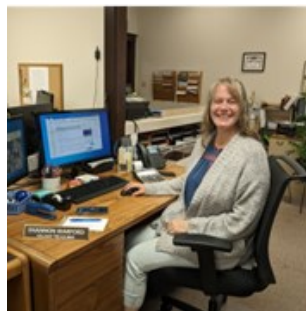
BECOME A REGISTERED VOTER!!

The Village has had a very busy summer and projects to improve the Village continue to move forward. The new pedestrian crosswalk and signs have been installed at DeKalb Drive and County Line Road to provide a designated crossing area. The Village has been discussing the parking for downtown businesses and recently approved a study to review and make recommendations for parking improvements. The Village is excited to announce that the water tower project is underway. The addition of a second water tower will provide additional water pressure and capacity for the Village for years to come. The groundbreaking and foundation work is beginning in August. The Village continues to look for grant opportunities and has received \$40,000 for playground equipment at Memorial Park to be planned for 2024. The Village will be making an investment in the Civic Center and Village Offices to replace one of the oldest boilers in the State of Illinois. The project will take place in the coming months and is estimated to finish before the end of the year. We are all looking forward to this year's Fun Fest. Thank you to the Fun Fest Committee for all of their work. The Village is very fortunate to have a group of citizens, residents and business owners, to plan and execute a great Labor Day weekend event. Thank you to everyone that helps make the Village of Maple Park a great place to live.
