



The Village of Maple Park is monitoring the ever-changing information regarding the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19.) The Village is following the communication provided by the Illinois Department of Health (IDPH.) The Center for Disease Control (CDC) is posting updates on its website that includes summaries outlining case numbers and a map and list of the affected states and counties. To help prevent the spread of COVID-19 please:

1. Avoid all non-essential travel to China.
2. Stay home if you don't feel well.
3. Maintain a social distance (3 feet) between yourself and anyone who is coughing or sneezing.
4. Avoid visiting long-term care facilities, such as a nursing home, especially if you're sick.
5. Cover your mouth if you cough or sneeze.
6. Don't touch your eyes, nose and mouth with unwashed hands.
7. Wash your hands often with soap and water, remember the 20 second rule (think the chorus of "Stayin' Alive" by the Bee Gees.) If soap and water are unavailable, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer.
8. Plan a safe visit to the doctor if you're experiencing any symptoms.

**The Village will continue to monitor the situation and until a determination is made otherwise, the Village will continue to hold its regularly scheduled meetings of the Village Board; Finance, Infrastructure, Personnel Committee and Plan Commission meetings. If the determination is made to cancel a meeting, the Village will send out a meeting cancellation notice as soon possible. Meeting cancellation notices will be posted on the Village's web site and on the main entry door to the Civic Center, 302 Willow Street, Mapl Park. Committee and Commission meeting members will also be notified as soon as possible with any meeting cancellation notices.**

Organizations and families utilizing Village meeting rooms and/or the gym are strongly encouraged to evaluate their need for the usage of the room/gym at this time and request that group participants that are not feeling well should practice self-care and stay home.
