**AN ORDINANCE FOR THE LEVY AND COLLECTION OF TAXES FOR THE
VILLAGE OF MAPLE PARK, KANE AND DEKALB COUNTIES FOR 2024 TAX LEVY,
PAYABLE IN 2025**

WHEREAS, the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Maple Park, Kane and DeKalb Counties, Illinois, have determined that it is in the best interests of said Village and its residents to authorize a levy of Village property taxes for a total of \$282,453.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Maple Park at a Regular Board Meeting assembled December 3, 2024.

SECTION 1. That there be, and is hereby levied upon all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the Village of Maple Park subject to tax, for \$282,453.

SECTION 2. That each of the aforesaid sums and the aggregate thereof are deemed necessary by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Maple Park to defray the expenses and liabilities of the Village.

SECTION 3. That the Deputy Clerk of the Village of Maple Park be and is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this Ordinance with the County Clerk of Kane and DeKalb Counties, Illinois, as required by law.

SECTION 4. That, if any part of parts of this Ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or otherwise invalid, such unconstitutionality or invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remaining parts of this Ordinance. The Village Board of the Village of Maple Park hereby declares that it would have passed the remaining parts of this Ordinance if it had known that such part or parts would be declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid.

SECTION 5. That this Ordinance shall be known as Ordinance No. 2024-12 Tax Levy, and shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with law.
