**AN ORDINANCE CORRECTING TITLE 6 “POLICE REGULATIONS,” CHAPTER 3
“GENERAL OFFENSES,” SECTION 6-1 “OPEN LIQUOR CONTAINERS” OF THE
MAPLE PARK VILLAGE CODE**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Maple Park, Illinois as follows:

Section 1: That Title 6 “Police Regulations,” Chapter 3 “General Offenses,” Section 6-1 “Open Liquor Containers” of the Village Code of Maple Park, Illinois be corrected by changing “Filmore Park” referenced in 6-3-6-1-B to “Lions Park.”

Section 2: That each section, paragraph, sentence, clause and provision of this Ordinance is separable and if any provision is held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance nor any part thereof, other than the part affected by such decision.

Section 3: That except as to the correction heretofore mentioned, all chapters and sections of the Village Code of Maple Park, Illinois, shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4: That this Ordinance shall, by authority of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Maple Park, Illinois, be published in pamphlet form. From and after ten days after said publication, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect.

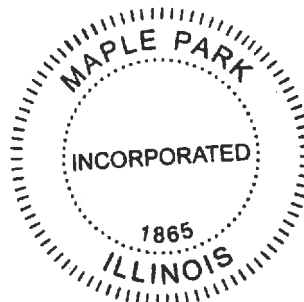
