**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 5 “PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY”,  
CHAPTER 9 “OPEN BURNING AND RECREATIONAL FIRES”  
OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF MAPLE PARK**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Maple Park, Illinois has determined that it is in the best interest and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Maple Park to regulate open burning and recreational fires within the village; and

**WHEREAS**, through this Ordinance the Board of Trustees intends to remove the requirement to obtain a burning permit.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Maple Park Kane and DeKalb Counties, Illinois, in a regular session duly assembled, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** That **Title 5, PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY**, is hereby amended as noted in Exhibit A **Open Burning and Recreational Fires**, as attached.

**SECTION 2. VALIDITY**

- A. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent that they conflict with this Ordinance, or any part of this Ordinance.
- B. If any provision contained in this Ordinance is found to be invalid, such provision shall be deemed to be severable and shall not affect the validity of any of the remaining provision of the ordinance.

**SECTION 3. ORDINANCE IN FORCE**

- A. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.

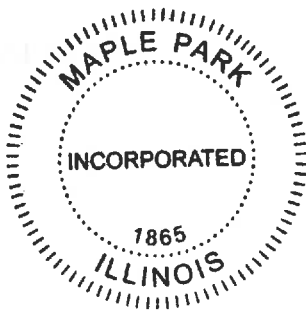
